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Introduction

You and your team may be serving individuals from many diverse cultures seeking behavioral health supports. While each person is facing unique and complex issues that may contribute to or impact their behavioral health needs, you and your team may not feel equipped to welcome diverse clients into your agency.

Through the Faith and Community Based Stigma Reduction Initiative, a network of professionals has emerged that offer in-community experience with many of the populations you may encounter.

This directory highlights professionals at organizations with in-community experience, as well as resources and materials that are available around the state from Faith and Community Based Stigma Reduction Initiative funded organizations. These resources and materials aim to reduce stigma around seeking help for behavioral health care, increase organizations' cultural competency and help bridge the gap for Ohioans from special populations.

Within each region, organizations are listed along with the special populations that they serve and information and short descriptions of materials that they have created. 


